My dear Fathers, Sisters and Brothers,

Faith in the resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ is one of the central doctrines of Christianity. The life, liturgy, creed, and day-to-day faith of Christians prove this point.

Just as the Trinity, the church and the Eucharist, the resurrection of the Lord too is a multidimensional mystery. No amount of theological explanation can make us understand the truth of this mystery. God alone can teach us what it means. For mysteries are revealed by God and they are to be received in faith and lived. Sometimes, more than theological discussions, a prayerful contemplation of the Gospel scenes can give us a profound insight into the mystery of the resurrection and fill us with Easter joy.

To believe in the resurrection is more than simply accepting that God will raise the dead. It means believing in Jesus' Resurrection. And that means believing that Jesus is now Lord, and now offers us a share of risen life. To truly believe in Jesus' Resurrection is to perceive it as the central reality on which we build our lives. And to do what makes us Christians.

The resurrection is not only a future reality, but a present one. By raising Jesus from the dead not at the end of time, but right in the middle of it, God has injected the resurrection's power into the present age. It is more than a future hope, which can comfort and motivate us; it is a life changing reality — a power — for us here and now. To believe in the resurrection is to allow ourselves to be affected by it. In baptism we are joined to Jesus not only in his death but also in his rising from the dead.

To be Christian is to cooperate with Jesus' risen power at work in us. To read the scriptural passages about resurrection and ponder them, is only half a response. The other half is to pray them, and enter into the reality they are talking about.

My faith in the Easter Event allows me to acknowledge that Jesus is Lord and Saviour of every situation on earth.

This means that, despite appearances to the seeming

With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and much grace was upon them all.

Be Joyful in Hope Patience in Affliction and Faithful in Prayer.

Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die.

In 11:25-26

contrary, my faith and that of the Church for two thousand years teaches me to believe that Jesus is always and everywhere the supreme 'In-Charge'. This is the dogmatic basis for the Saints' unshakable trust which witnesses powerfully to others in time of great stress and danger.

The saintly archbishop Oscar Romero is a shining example for this. I quote here the very words he spoke just two weeks before his murder on March 24, 1980: "I have often been threatened with death. Nevertheless, as a Christian, I do not believe in death without resurrection. If they kill me, I shall arise in the Salvadoran people. I say so without meaning to boast, with the greatest humility. As pastor; I am obliged by divine mandate to give my life for those I love- for all Salvadorans, even for those who may be going to kill me.... let my blood be a seed of freedom and the sign that hope will soon be reality. Let my death, if it is accepted by God, be for the liberation of my people and as a witness of hope in the future."

May the risen Lord grant you unshakable faith, boundless joy, undying hope and abiding peace! With the power of the Holy Spirit dwelling in you, may you succeed in transforming every evil into a blessing and every wound into a grace! I close this reflection with the words of St. Paul: "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God for you. Do not quench the Spirit.... test everything; hold fast to what is good; abstain from every form of evil" (1Th 5:16-22).

### **GUIDELINES FOR TRANSFERS AND APPOINTMENTS, APRIL 2014**

I am attaching along with this circular the list of Transfers and appointments, which will come into effect from May 15, 2014. Kindly fix a mutually agreeable date, not later than June 25, 2014, to assume or hand over the office.

When a priest is transferred, he should leave his place for his successor in a way he expects to find his new place. It is good to remember that our mission is that of our Lord Jesus Christ. We should ensure that our successors do not have any difficulty because of our carelessness or negligence. Hence the need to keep the account books, the stock registers, and various other files up-to-date. There should be no undeclared pending bills, no unauthorized loans and no unjustifiable deficit for the next priest to take care of.

Parishes and institutions should maintain inventories. If there isn't an inventory in a parish/mission station/institution, please make one; if there is one, kindly update it before leaving it over to the incoming priest.
